What is the National Skills Competition?

The National Skills Competition aims to discover and nurture South Korea's outstanding skilled technicians. A prestigious competition with a 57-year history, it has produced approximately 300,000 prospective skilled technicians, with various benefits offered to the winners.



When is it held and who can participate?

This year's National Skills Competition runs for a week, starting on October 14th. Those aged 14 and above with outstanding results can participate. Eligible participants include the top three winners and excellence awardees from regional skills competitions, and winners from private skills competitions recognized by the Ministry of Employment and Labor.



The National Skills Competition features these categories!

Machinery

There are 8 professions, including cooling technology, industrial drone control, and mechanical design/CAD.

Metal & Transportation

There are 8 professions, including welding, pipefitting, car repair, and agricultural machinery repair.

Electrical & Electronics

There are 8 professions, including industrial robots, electrical control, and electrical devices.

Construction & Wood

There are 5 professions, including tiling, furniture, interior decoration, carpentry, and architectural design/CAD.

IT & Design

There are 9 professions, including information technology, web design and development, and graphic design.

Crafts & Clothing

There are 6 professions, including woodwork, precious metal crafts, costume design, and traditional Korean attire (Hanbok).

Arts & Performance

There are 6 professions, including floral decoration, hair design, cooking, and baking.

What if you win at the National Skills Competition?



1. Employment Opportunities

Many well-known major companies sponsor the skills competition. **These companies not only sponsor the event but also recruit talented individuals.** According to the Korea Industrial Training Institute, over the past decade, a total of 1,470 winners from national and regional skills competitions have been employed by major companies.



2. Cash Prizes by Profession

The first place is awarded 10 million won, the second place receives 6 million won, the third place gets 4 million won, and the excellence award (equivalent to fourth place) is given 500,000 won. Participants with high scores, who don't secure a top position, are eligible for a commendation prize of 200,000 won.



3. Participation in International Competitions

The winners of 1st and 2nd places in each category **can participate in the evaluation for the International Skills Olympics**, held every two years. Representing our country with your skills is truly an exhilarating experience.
